Offshore-ready helm seat


The Marine Pilothouse Chair is one of the most comfortable and durable upholstered seats in the company's line. "Intended for use in open seas, it's suitable for the bridge on a big pleasure yacht or a workboat," said Sweeney.

Rugged construction features include an internal, powder-coated steel frame for strength and corrosion-resistance. For comfort, key features are the 45-degree recline and molded armrests that swing up when the skipper needs to leave his seat or just lean over to reach a piece of electronics or simply open the door at the bridge for a passenger.

Electric slide

"One of the most important elements of a seat is the slide/swivel underneath it," said Sweeney. "This mechanical piece affects both comfort and performance. Springfield offers a number of slides/swivels to meet the various adjustment requirements of boat owners."

New from Springfield is the Mariner II, 4-inch Electric Slide; a 12-volt-powered unit that fits any Springfield Marine 4-inch pedestal. It's designed to be paired with the company's hydraulically adjustable pedestal, but this slide can also be used with the fixed-height and gas-rise pedestals. It features the strength and durability of the traditional Mariner II slide, only with a power option that offers a full six inches of slide travel. Like all Springfield products, it comes with a five-year warranty.

The third new product from Springfield Marine is the hydraulic 12-volt Electric Pedestal, which is engineered to lift an impressive 1,000 pounds. Available in polished aluminum or 316 stainless steel, it requires just 7-amps to lift 500 pounds. It's compatible with all Springfield 4-inch slide/swivels and it's available with up to 12 inches of vertical travel.

"With this pedestal, you can get the height adjustment you want without having to stand up," said Sweeney. "Operation is quiet, too, at just 60 decibels."

To control movement, the helmsman can use a hard-wired DPDT switch or a wireless key fob remote.

"We spend a lot of time and effort engineering new products to cover a broad spectrum of boats," said Sweeney. "We control every step of the production process, and we believe that our OEM clients and aftermarket customers appreciate the high-quality products we make."
