

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR MARINER SLIDE AND 4" SS MAINSTAY PEDESTAL

- 1.** Position the pedestal (FIG2, 1) in the boat. Face the "Mount to Front" label located on the pedestal base towards the front of the boat. Secure the base to the boat deck using 6 stainless steel screws a minimum diameter of 14 (not included). NOTE: Due to variations in deck materials and design Springfield Marine cannot recommend a fastener type. Please see your boat dealer or manufacturer. Per ABYC requirements each fastener installation must withstand a tensile force of 750lbs without pulling out. Fasteners threaded into plywood must have some other means of securing such as a metal backing plate or deck ring.
- 2.** Position the slide assembly (FIG1, 2) on the seat bottom with the desired handle orientation. Using the four slots in the slide plate to secure the slide to the seat bottom with a minimum #12 screw. T-Nuts or Nylon locknuts are recommended (not included).
- 3.** To place the seat onto the pedestal loosen the Swivel Tension Pin (FIG1, 3) by turning it counterclockwise. Start the swivel on to the top of the pedestal. Pull out on the Post Lock Pin and rotate the seat until the Post Lock Pin locks into the slot on the pedestal (FIG2, 5) and will no longer allow the seat to rotate. Tighten the Swivel Tension Pin.
- 4.** Once installed onto the pedestal the Post Lock Pin will not be used again except during removal. The Swivel Tension Pin will need to be periodically tightened but all rotation of the seat is accomplished within the slide assembly itself, not between the slide assembly and the post.

To operate the Slide and Swivel functions of the slide assembly simply pull out on the appropriate activation handle (FIG1, 6 and 7 respectively).

To adjust the height of the pedestal, loosen the Pedestal Tension Handle (FIG2, 8) by turning it counterclockwise. Then lift up on the Air-Ride Activation Handle (FIG1, 9). Once the desired height is reached tighten the Pedestal Tension Handle to remove any excess wobble or rotational play in the pedestal.
